WINTER REMINDERS FROM PUBLIC WORKS

Parking is prohibited on all streets when snow/ice covered.

- * It is the responsibility of the resident to remove snow/ice from the sidewalk with 24 hours after the storm.
- * It is also the responsibility of the resident to remove snow/ice from a fire hydrant that is located on their property or within the right of way abutting the property.
- * Shoveling, blowing or plowing snow into the roadway is prohibited.
- * Inform any plowing contractors that plowing snow into the street is prohibited.
- * Remove all basketball hoops from the roadways to eliminate any possibility of damage.

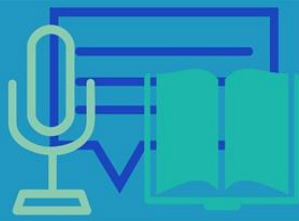
