Did you know there is a program for Senior Citizens and/or Veteran's to receive a deduction on their property taxes? Senior Citizens must be 65 years of age and meet certain income requirements. Veterans must have served during applicable service periods (a copy of the Veteran's DD214 must be included to see if you qualify).
