The Township of Roxbury is undergoing a town-wide revaluation. The first step of the revaluation process is the inspection of all properties in the Township. In the coming months inspectors from Appraisal Systems, Inc. will visit your property, measuring and photographing only the exterior of all buildings and inspecting the interior. There is an interactive map to see which locations the inspectors are currently in. There is also information about the inspector's themselves i.e. height, hair/eye color along with their vehicle description make, model, color, license plate.
