WINTER ROAD REMINDERS

REMEMBER THAT A SNOWPLOW OPERATOR'S FIELD OF VISION IS RESTRICTED.

YOU MAY SEE THEM, BUT THEY MAY NOT SEE YOU!

- Remove basketball hoops from the roadways to eliminate any possibility of damage.
- Parking is *prohibited* on all streets when snow/ice covered.
- Shoveling, blowing or plowing snow into the roadway is *prohibited*.
- Please inform any residential plowing contractors that plowing snow into the street is *prohibited*.
- Residents must remove snow/ice from the sidewalk *within 24 hours* after any storm.
- It is the responsibility of the resident to remove snow/ice from a fire hydrant that is located on their property or within the right of way abutting the property.
