Welcome to Roxbury Township, selected by America's Promise Alliance as one of the nations Top 100 Communities for Young People. Roxbury Township consists of 6 unique communities including Berkshire Valley, Kenvil, Landing, Ledgewood, Port Morris, and Succasunna. It is home to over 23,000 residents and covers an area of approximately 22 square miles.

We boast 15 parks and recreational facilities, which are beautifully maintained by the Parks and Recreation Department. The Horseshoe Lake Recreation Complex, located at 72 Eyland Avenue, was voted the top recreational facility in Morris County in 2014 by the Daily Record, and New Jersey Family magazine consistently lists Imagination Station Playground as a destination playground. This facility includes a lake with a beach and swimming area, picnic areas, a pavilion, gazebo, band shell, walking/bike path, Imagination Station playground, and sports fields for football, soccer, baseball, lacrosse, softball, basketball, and volleyball. In addition, the Horseshoe Lake walking/bike path connects with the West Morris Greenway, an extension of Patriots Path for many miles of walking, jogging or biking. Several of our other parks include family friendly rustic hiking trails with beautiful views of ponds or scenic vistas as well as a fishing pond at our Ledgewood Park/Morris Canal Park. A Community Garden, located on Eyland Avenue, contains plots for cultivating flowers and vegetables, and is available on a first-come, first-served basis. 
Town Hall and the Roxbury Police Department are located at 1715 Route 46 in Ledgewood. The Town Hall houses the Construction/Building Department, Engineering, Planning & Zoning, Tax and Utilities Collector, Tax Assessor, Administration, Municipal Clerk, and Fire Prevention Department as well as the Municipal Court. The Department of Public Works and the Recycling Center are both located at 96 North Dell Avenue in Kenvil.

The 72 Eyland Ave. facility is home to the Recreation Department, Health Department, Department of Social Services and Animal Control. It is also home to our Teen Center, Performing Arts Center and Senior Citizen Cubs. Please see the attached sheet for important pertinent information regarding these departments.

Roxbury Township is served by an all volunteer staff of Firefighters, EMT's and First Responders. These volunteers operate out of three individual Fire Companies; Company 1 in Succasunna, Company 2 in Landing and Company 3 in Berkshire Valley. 

## Roxbury Event Notification System

The Roxbury Event Notification System enables the Township to communicate information such as “What’s Happening in Town”, severe weather, crime alerts, missing persons, community events, and municipal utility service issues through every communication device—including mobile phones, landlines, smartphones, email, text messaging, instant messaging, and more.

This Notification system, customized for Roxbury, is being efficiently handled by the county. This will take you to the county web page where you will be able to customize what information you receive and how you receive it.

**TO: All Homeowners, Realtors, and Attorneys**

**RE: Certificate of Smoke Detector / Carbon Monoxide Alarm Compliance / Fire Extinguisher Inspections**

This is to inform you that under the New Jersey Uniform Fire Code all homes sold, leased, or otherwise made subject to a change of occupancy for residential purposes, the owner shall obtain a Smoke Detector / Carbon Monoxide Alarm/ Fire Extinguisher Compliance Certificate.

1. Smoke Detectors for one and two-family dwellings shall be installed as follows:
  - 1) On each level of the premises; and
  - 2) Outside of each separate sleeping area

The Smoke Detectors required shall be located in accordance with NFPA 74-1984, incorporated herein by reference, and maintained in working order.

- 1) The detectors shall not be required to be interconnected.

Smoke Detectors may be battery powered and shall be listed in accordance with ANSI/UL 217, incorporated herein by reference.

- 1) A/C powered smoke detectors shall be accepted as meeting the Requirements of this section.

Smoke Detectors that are hardwired due to the construction must properly operate.

2. Starting on April 7, 2003, the New Jersey Uniform Fire Code requires the owners of one & two family dwellings as well as multiple dwellings to install Carbon Monoxide Alarms when their homes are sold.

The new code relates to structures containing a fuel-burning appliance and/or an attached garage, requires each dwelling unit contain at least one carbon monoxide alarm. Alarms may be battery operated, and shall be listed in accordance with UL-2034, and must be installed in the immediate vicinity of the sleeping areas per NFPA-720.

3. A Fire Extinguisher must be installed in the kitchen or 10 feet visible from the kitchen. It must be mounted on the wall, and cannot be placed on counter tops or behind closed cabinet doors. It shall be no higher than 5 feet off the ground, weigh no heavier than 10lbs. But it must meet the minimum required rating of a 2A:10BC rated extinguisher.

The Fire Official or Fire Inspector of the Township of Roxbury shall be responsible for the enforcement of these state mandated laws and its compliance. The current fee for an inspection is \$50.00. Inspections that are requested within 48 hours will pay \$125.00 as per NJAC 5:70-2.9 (d). If the inspection fails there will be an additional \$25.00 fee paid at the time the inspection passes.

Upon approval, the Fire Official/ Inspector will issue a Certificate of Approval to be given to the purchaser at the time of closing. The Certificate of Approval is only valid for 6 months from the date of inspection.

4. Requests for an Inspection must be made at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to when the inspection is needed. To schedule an inspection, please call the fire prevention bureau. The bureau is currently only staffed by part-time employees, so please leave a voice mail and we will return your call as soon as possible to schedule your inspection. THERE IS NO NEED TO VISIT THE FIRE PREVENTION BUREAU BECAUSE THERE ARE NO FORMS TO BE FILLED OUT. ALL INFORMATION WILL BE TAKEN OVER THE PHONE TO SCHEDULE THE INSPECTION.

**To All Purchasers of Property in the Township of Roxbury**

**SUBJECT: Soil Relocation, Zoning and Constructions Permits**

The Township of Roxbury would like to congratulate you on the purchase of your new home.

Please be advised that re-grading, removal, or filling of soil on your property is a regulated activity under Chapter 17 of the Roxbury Township General Ordinances, and requires the issuance of a soil relocation permit. The purpose of this requirement is to prevent drainage problems on your property and protect adjacent properties and Township rights-of-way. The Engineering Department must issue a permit prior to any soil disturbance of twenty (20) cubic yards or more. In addition, any retaining wall greater than four (4) feet in height requires a site plan and structural design calculations be approved in accordance with the Land Development Ordinance Chapter 13-8.809. Please contact the Engineering Department at 973-448-2018 with any questions or concerns you may have.

Also, remember to check with the Zoning Office and Construction Office to see if a permit is required for any home improvements. This includes the installation of pools, patios, hot tubs, fences, walls, sheds and driveway expansions. If you have any questions, please call the Zoning Office at (973) 448-2008 or the Construction Office at (973)448-2009.

## Black River Park

The scenic trail on the property is level and suitable for walking for all ages. The gold-marked path within the park is approximately .85 miles, and has a small loop. Most of the trail is along the Black River, and has some dips and roots to cross. Things to look for: a beautiful line of cedar trees, which shaded horses in their past, and two bridges to cross a stream. There's a small hill, which used to be a ski hill. A pair of swans are often seen in Black River Pond, as well as turtles. Beavers attempt to dam the river from time to time. The far end of the trail connects with trails leading to Mine Hill and Randolph.

**Parking:** 1 Main Street, Succasunna.

## Ice Age Trail at Orben Park

Our newest trail includes a 1.5 mile hike offering beautiful views from the top of the ridge line, overlooking Mt. Arlington and Landing. Some steep areas, trekking up and down the hillside. On a clear day, Allamuchy Mountain can be seen. **Parking:** 9 Orben Drive, Landing.

## Horseshoe Lake Park's bike path connection to West Morris Greenway

Horseshoe Lake's paved Bike Path circles the entire park, and is 1.65 miles in distance. The connection to the WMG trail is located at the southeastern corner of the long bike path (behind the Roxbury Day Care Center, where paved bike path parallels railroad tracks). The wide path crosses Righter Road and continues on an easement through a beautiful, level route along the MCMUA's property, perfect for walking or biking. This connection goes out to Pleasant Hill Road in Randolph; this distance is 1.5 miles, or a 3-mile round trip. From there, the path narrows, and continues to Pleasant Hill Road in Chester. From the start at HSL, the connection to Chester is a 5-mile route, or a 10-mile round trip. Connections to Patriots Path. Suitable for all ages.

**Parking:** 72 Eyland Avenue, Succasunna or 9 Righter Road, Succasunna.

# Enjoy a hike on the natural, earthy trails of Roxbury...

## Ledgewood Park/Morris Canal Park

Together, these parks are comprised of over 250 acres of forest, offering a pond and hiking trails. There are two trails in the park, the gold and blue trails, which partially overlap one another. These trails have wet areas to cross, which are more challenging during the spring season. The gold trail, which is 1.35 miles, has challenging, narrow, and rocky areas. The top offers a scenic northern view. There are large rock outcroppings along the trail. The blue trail is .9 miles long, and is largely a wide, unpaved easement road, making it a great trail for children. There are elevation changes and rocky areas along the trail, plus some wet areas to cross. Remnants of the Morris Canal are currently being restored.

**Parking:** Emmans Road, Ledgewood; between #8 and #10 Emmans Road.

### Garden Trail

A fun walk behind the Community Garden, 1/4 mile long. Great for kids.

## Veteran's Park-New Trail!

This beautiful park offers 240 acres of wooded land containing four marked hiking trails, which require different levels of ability. The blue trail, accessible at two separate trailheads, is mostly an unpaved easement road with slight hills. Suitable for walking and biking at most levels of ability; length of trail is one mile. Things to look for: large rock outcroppings, and two dirt bikes about 25' up in the trees. The gold trail, accessible on Patricia Drive and also at an intersection off of the blue trail, is a challenging trail. It winds through the woods and is very narrow and rocky in places, with a distance of 1/2 mile. Things to look for: scenic overlook of Succasunna valley, Table Rock, and other rock outcroppings. **New Red Trail!** This addition explores the eastern side of Mooney Mountain. It creates a loop connecting the blue and yellow trails, and is more technical as it winds its way through woodlands and rocky terrain. Total loop is 3 miles. The green trail, accessible from Patricia Drive, is a loop trail 1.17 miles long and is great for children. Things to look for: scenic overlook and picnic area. **Parking:** 45 Patricia Drive, Flanders for all four trails; parking is also available at 40 Conkling Road in Ledgewood for the blue and red trails.

## Hiking Basics

For Roxbury trails, which are between 1/2 and 3 miles long, be prepared:

- wear appropriate footwear, such as sneakers or hiking boots
- bring water and snack
- bring cell phone (service may be spotty on the trails)
- tick spray

Remember to:

- tell someone where you are going and when you will be back
- leave no trace, carry out what you brought in, and feel free to bring a bag to collect any litter
- clean up after your dog
- in an emergency, contact 911
- avoid poison ivy; leaves of three, let it be!



**Horseshoe Lake Recreation Complex** is a beautiful site which offers Imagination Station playground, picnic areas, a lake with designated swimming area, fishing, lighted basketball courts, two volleyball courts, four softball/baseball fields, and soccer fields. **New at the beach: Sprinkler Park with Adirondack chairs, plus a shade structure!** The park also features a ½ mile walking path, and a 1.7 mile paved bikeway/walking/running path. The West Morris Greenway, a branch of Patriots Path, connects with the park and adds a 5-mile path to Chester. A 40'x80' pavilion is available for large group gatherings, along with a covered stage area. The Island hosts a scenic gazebo with surrounding benches. The Veteran's Memorial Park is located within the park. Special events are held in the park year-round. Location: 72 Eyland Avenue, Succasunna.

**Berkshire Valley Park** is a neighborhood playground with a 1/8 mile walking path, surrounding a baseball field. This park includes a **newly renovated tennis court, plus a court lined for basketball, street hockey and Foursquare.** Location: 79 Mill Road, Wharton.

**Black River Park** is located on the Black River Pond and offers **benches and a picnic area** pondside. There is a trail through wooded areas along the Black River, which links up to Mine Hill and Randolph trails. Location: 1 Main Street, Succasunna.

**Dell Avenue Park** offers a fenced-in playground area geared toward younger children, and includes picnic tables. It also contains basketball courts and baseball fields. Location: 56 N. Dell Avenue, Kenvil.

**Emmans Park** contains soccer fields, a baseball field and an **updated dog park**, containing fun accouterments such as a fire hydrant, a bridge and a tube. Location: 75 Emmans Road, Ledgewood.

**New! Ice Age Trail** is a 1.3 mile hike with some steep areas, trekking up and down the hillside. Beautiful views from the ridge line, overlooking Mt. Arlington and Landing. Location: across from 12 Orben Drive, Landing.

**Kiwanis Park** offers a playground, lighted baseball fields, and three lighted tennis courts. Location: 9 Makin Lane, Succasunna.

**Coming Soon! Landing Park**, located at 165 Landing Road, Landing.

**Ledgewood Park/Morris Canal Park** together are comprised of over 250 acres of forest land, offering a fishing pond and hiking trails. For viewing, remnants of the restored Morris Canal are along the trail. Location: Emmans Road, Ledgewood; turn at Morris Canal Park driveway, which is between #8 and #10 Emmans Road.

**Midland Park** offers a small pond surrounded by a natural area with a wooded path. Location: 9 Midland Road, Succasunna.

**Mooney Mountain Park/Conkling Pond** is a neighborhood park containing a playground area and a paved basketball court. Neighboring Conkling Pond is a perfect spot to fish. Location: Intersection of Conkling Road and Kennedy Drive on Mooney Mountain in Flanders.

**Nalron Park** contains one softball field. Location: 67 Emmans Road, Ledgewood.

**Port Morris Park** offers a playground area, a basketball court, and a softball field. Location: 23 Washington Street, Landing.

**Shore Hills Park** is a neighborhood park area with a playground. Location: 83 Vail Road, Landing.

**Righter Road Fields** (Succasunna Fields) contains two baseball fields. Location: 175 Righter Road, Succasunna.

**Veteran's Park** offers 240 acres of wooded land containing hiking trails, which offer scenic views of the Succasunna Valley. Location: 45 Patricia Drive, Flanders.

**Vickery Community Gardens** is farmland that has been converted into a community garden. More information is available at [www.roxburyec.org](http://www.roxburyec.org). Location: 281 Eyland Avenue, Succasunna.


