



# Roxbury Township Primary Election Tuesday, July 7, 2020



The **Primary Election on July 7, 2020** is being conducted primarily by mail per Executive Order #144 signed by Governor Murphy on May 15, 2020.

**Voters are strongly encouraged to complete their mail-in-ballot and return to the Board of Elections via:**

- US Postal Service mail using the postage-paid envelope (must be postmarked on or before July 7, 2020); or
- drop-off at one of the “Morris County Official Ballot Drop Boxes” (one drop box is located in each of the following municipalities: Morristown, Mount Olive, Rockaway Twp., Montville, Madison); or
- deliver in-person to the Board of Elections Office in Morristown up until 8:00 p.m. on July 7th.

**Mail-in ballots cannot be accepted at Roxbury Town Hall.**

The **Roxbury Municipal Building (Town Hall)** located at 1715 Route 46 in Ledgewood **will be open between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.** on July 7, 2020 for **registered voters from any ward/district within the Township of Roxbury** for voting as follows:

- Roxbury voters who have a disability and need an accessible ballot will be given a headset and accessible device to cast their vote.
- Any other registered Roxbury voter who comes to Town Hall on election day **will only be allowed to vote using a provisional (paper) ballot.**

## **Vote-By-Mail (VBM) Drop Boxes**

- Vote-by-Mail Drop Boxes are installed in (5) locations across Morris County for voters to drop their voted VBM ballots in as opposed to mailing them.
- Vote-by-Mail Drop Boxes are all outside and under surveillance 24/7. They resemble a USPS Blue Mailbox, but are Red, White & Blue and display “Morris County – Official Ballot Drop Box”.
- The VBM ballots will be picked up on a daily basis and brought to the Board of Elections. All Security measures will be followed when collecting and transporting the VBMs.
- VBM Drop Boxes will be closed at 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 7th.
