GENERAL ELECTION – NOVEMBER 3, 2020

*Governor Murphy's Executive Order #177 (EO-177) has ordered the General Election to be conducted primarily by mail-in ballot. **Voting machines WILL NOT BE USED during this election.*** The Township of Roxbury must comply with state mandates. I. VOTERS WILL RECEIVE A BALLOT IN MAIL

All registered voters should have received a vote-by-mail ballot and a postage-paid return envelope from the Morris County Clerk's Office (*Damaged, Misplaced or Did Not Receive Your Mail-in Ballot? Contact the Morris County Clerk's Office at CountyClerk@co.morris.nj.us. Include your full name, date of birth, address, and phone number in all email correspondences.*)

II. VOTERS CAST THEIR VOTE (via one of the following methods):

1. **Mail-In Ballot - submitted by returning to the County in one of the following ways:**

- a. complete as instructed and mail in the postage-paid return envelope via United States Postal Service
- b. complete as instructed and drop into one of the sixteen drop boxes located throughout Morris County
- c. complete as instructed and submit in-person to the Board of Election Office in Morristown
- d. complete as instructed and bring to your assigned consolidated General Election 2020 polling location (*voters will receive a separate card in the mail containing location information*) on November 3, 2020 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., and submit directly to a poll worker.

2. **Paper ("provisional") Ballot - submitted in-person to a poll worker on election day:**

- Go to your assigned consolidated General Election 2020 polling location (*voters will receive a separate card in the mail containing location information*) on November 3, 2020 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., complete a paper ("provisional") ballot and submit directly to a poll worker.

The drop boxes are all outside and under surveillance 24/7. They resemble a USPS Blue Mailbox, but are Red, White & Blue and display “Morris County – Official Ballot Drop Box.”

The Vote-By-Mail ballots (VBMs) will be picked up on a daily basis and brought to the Morris County Board of Elections.

All Security measures will be followed when collecting and transporting the VBMs.
