RIDER - A

- 1. The contractor shall properly guard the excavation by the erection of suitable barricades and warning signs. Warning flags and amber flashing lights shall be provided as required.
- 2. The work shall be arranged in such a manner as to cause a minimum of inconvenience and delay to vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
- 3. Where the free flow of traffic is interfered with, the contractor shall furnish competent persons to direct and expedite traffic. Vehicular traffic shall be maintained at all times during the progress of the work.
- 4. No Township road shall be closed to traffic without the prior consent of the Police Department and Engineering/Public Works Department, contingent upon approval of appropriate detour plan.
- 5. Before excavating in areas of pavement, each edge of the trench shall be neatly sawcut.
- 6. The material excavated from the trench opening shall not be used as backfill unless specifically permitted by the Township Engineer or his authorized representative. Backfill material shall meet the requirements of Soil Aggregate Type 5-A or 3/4" quarry process stone or approved equivalent.
- 7. Backfill materials shall be deposited in thoroughly compacted layers by mechanical tamper. At no time shall the thickness of each layer exceed twelve (12) inches.
- 8. Immediately after backfilling, the contractor shall repair any pavement disturbed as follows:
 - Temporary pavement restoration shall consist of a base course of six (6) inches of bituminous stabilized base over four (4) inches of approved backfill material, soil aggregate type 5-A or 3/4" quarry process stone. The stabilized base shall be laid flush with the existing road surface.
 - Permanent pavement restoration shall be completed within six (6) to nine (9) months after completion of the temporary pavement restoration. The area to be restored shall be milled to a depth of two (2) inches and overlaid with a two (2) inch FABC-1 top course finished level with the adjacent pavement. The milling shall extend a minimum of one (1) foot beyond the original area disturbed.
- 9. All work shall be subject to inspection by the Township Engineer or his authorized representative. The contractor shall give notice at least 72 hours prior to commencement of work, and again at least ten hours before backfilling.

- 10. All work, including the temporary and permanent pavement restoration, shall be maintained in perfect order and repair during the required period of maintenance. The period of maintenance shall be considered as a period starting at the issuance of the permit and extending for a period of six months after the date of final completion of restoration work.
- II. In the event that the Township finds it necessary to make emergency repairs at any time during the period of maintenance, the cost of making such emergency repairs shall be charged against the permittee.
- 12. Special provisions shall be applicable for roads surfaced within five (5) years prior to the opening as set forth in Rider-B or as determined by the Township Engineer.

RIDER - B

Pavement Restoration Requirements for Newly Resurfaced Township Roads

The following pavement restoration program shall be followed for all Township streets resurfaced within five (5) years of the date of the permit:

The disturbed pavement shall be restored as specified in Rider-A8. In addition, the entire 1/2 width or full width of the pavement surface shall be milled and resurfaced with a two (2) inch FABC-1 top course at the direction of the Township Engineer.
