



Fenimore Landfill Update

(For Thursday, 8/22/2013)

DEP and its contractors are working 24/7 on the Fenimore Landfill to resolve the H2S odor problem.

Landfill Site Work

DEP and Handex are still evaluating the data from the vent testing. Construction of the most effective collection system is still under review. DEP will continue to provide updates on the progress.

Landfill Air Monitoring

At the request of town officials, ambient air samples were collected at the landfill overnight from August 15 to 16. These samples were analyzed for volatile organic compounds that are commonly found in the air. The data is still undergoing a quality assurance review.

Additional Monitors

DEP's air monitoring team conducted a field survey of the Roxbury Township area last week. The team evaluated existing H2S monitoring locations and examined the landfill and surrounding areas. The team is now working on its recommendations regarding locations for additional sites and what the sites will be monitoring.

A Look Ahead

Work on site will continue 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
