Landfill Site Work

DEP and its contractor Handex have completed the north section of the gas collection system. Pipes continue to be assembled on site as part of the construction of the south section of the gas collection system. That system is approximately one-third complete.

Air Monitoring Stations

All air monitors are in proper working order. The Township reported to the DEP on Monday, at the request of the property owners, that the Township relocated monitor 6 on Lazarus Drive approximately 800 feet from the previous location. The NJDEP will be installing two additional monitors. Once those monitors are in place a new map with locations will be placed on the Township website.

One of the new monitoring locations will be at the Ledgewood Pond. This location was used earlier by the Township and will now be re-established. Roxbury Township is assisting the DEP in locating an appropriate site for the southern monitor location.

A Look Ahead

Work on the site will continue 24 hours a day, seven days a week. DEP will continue to provide updates as progress is made.
