

Fenimore Landfill Update

DEP and its contractors are working on-site 24/7 to resolve the H2S odor problem.

Landfill Site Work

DEP and its contractor Handex have completed the north section of the gas collection system. Construction continues on the south section of the gas collection system. Work to provide utilities (gas, water and electric) to the site is underway. In the interim, generators and propane are at the landfill for onsite use.

Air Monitoring Stations

DEP is installing two additional monitors. Once those monitors are in place a new map with locations will be placed on the Township website.

One of the new locations will be at the Ledgewood Pond. This location was used earlier by the Township and will now be re-established.

The second additional H2S monitor will be located at the entrance to Fenimore Landfill along Mountain Road.

DEP is working with Roxbury Township's contractor to install the two additional monitors. This brings a total number of five H2S monitors in the network.

A Look Ahead

An exhaust stack for the gas treatment system will be erected over the weekend. DEP and its contractors will be on site Saturday and Sunday. DEP and its contractors will not be on site from Sunday at 6 p.m. through Monday. 24/7 operations will resume immediately Tuesday morning.
