Landfill Site Work

On Saturday, September 7, DEP will begin testing the gas collection and treatment system at the Fenimore landfill. This system is designed to pull H₂S from the landfill and treat it. During all hours of testing operations, stringent protocols will be followed and highly trained personnel will be present. For details on the testing, see attached fact sheet.

Air Monitoring

On August 15-16, at the request of Roxbury Township, the DEP conducted air monitoring for 68 volatile organic compounds along the perimeter of the landfill overnight. Results of the testing concluded that all samples were below screening levels and pose no environmental or health risk at this time.

The five H₂S air monitoring stations will continue to operate 24/7 and the data is telemetered to DEP for review.

A Look Ahead

Testing of the gas collection and treatment system will continue throughout the weekend.
