Landfill Site Work

As planned, DEP and the engineering firm Handex started the five-day pilot test of the thermal oxidizer on Saturday, September 7. An update on the testing is attached.

Air Monitoring

At the request of the Roxbury Township School Superintendent, DOH conducted air sampling of three public schools and three non-public schools in an effort to determine indoor and ambient H2S levels prior to school opening. In addition, sampling of SO2 was conducted to establish background levels prior to testing the thermal oxidizer. A complete summary of the school testing results is attached.

A Look Ahead

Testing of the gas collection and treatment system will continue. Work also continues to bring gas, water, and electricity to the landfill for equipment operations.
