

**Fenimore Landfill Update**

### **Landfill Site Work**

Testing of the gas collection and treatment system continues. During all hours of testing operations, stringent protocols are being followed and highly trained personnel are on site. Construction of the utility corridor is continuing.

### **Air Monitoring**

On August 15-16, at the request of Roxbury Township, the DEP conducted air monitoring for 68 volatile organic compounds along the perimeter of the landfill overnight. Results of the testing concluded that all samples were below screening levels and pose no environmental or health risk at this time. The lab report is attached.

The five H<sub>2</sub>S air monitoring stations will continue to operate 24/7 and the data is telemetered to DEP for review.

### **A Look Ahead**

Testing of the gas collection and treatment system will continue. Work also continues to bring gas, water, and electricity to the landfill for equipment operations.
