

## **Fenimore Landfill Update**

### **Landfill Site Work**

DEP ran water through the interim scrubber to begin testing its operation.

Maintenance of the Posi-Shell® cap was done, with some spot application of additional material.

Site preparation work and offsite fabrication of the custom scrubber continues.

Work to connect utilities is ongoing.

### **Air Monitoring**

The five H<sub>2</sub>S air monitoring stations will continue to operate 24/7. The data is telemetered to DEP for review. In addition, the town's contractor, Emilcott, is developing a detailed plan that includes location of four more H<sub>2</sub>S monitors and a schedule for their installation.

The three SO<sub>2</sub> monitors that were set up in "mini-shelters" at the Vanover Well House, Lazarus Pump House, and Ledgewood Pond have all have been recording background conditions prior to operation of the scrubber.

### **A Look Ahead**

DEP plans to continue testing the interim scrubber over the next several days. There will likely be visible water vapor (steam) coming from the scrubber. During all testing, stringent protocols will be followed, highly trained personnel will be present, and additional air monitoring will be conducted.

Site preparations continue for the custom scrubber, which is being fabricated offsite. Work continues to bring water and electric utilities to the landfill for equipment operations.
