



## **Fenimore Landfill Update**

Saturday, February 1 – Monday, February 3, 2014

### **Landfill Site Work**

The custom treatment system is operating continually and all gas collected from the landfill is being directed to the custom system. DEP continues to monitor the emissions from the system to ensure it is operating safely.

The weather has caused on site construction activities to be suspended as of noon.

Moving and reconnecting the second oxidizer to the custom treatment system was completed. Testing of the second system will take place this month.

The pressure testing of the water line replacing the temporary water supply is expected to take place when the weather improves.

### **Air Monitoring**

The nine H<sub>2</sub>S and three SO<sub>2</sub> air monitoring stations continue to operate 24/7. To date, all SO<sub>2</sub> levels have been well within air quality standards. On Sunday, February 2, 2014, ROX 10 began sending out abnormal high spikes and readings of H<sub>2</sub>S concentration. DEP immediately investigated. It was determined that the spike was not associated with the landfill. Emilicott has been contacted so that the problem can be addressed.

### **A Look Ahead**

Limited truck traffic is needed to supply materials to the site. In addition, wastewater from the scrubbers will be trucked off the site periodically. For all necessary truck traffic, DEP will continue to work with local officials to ensure that safe traffic controls are in place utilizing the truck route.
